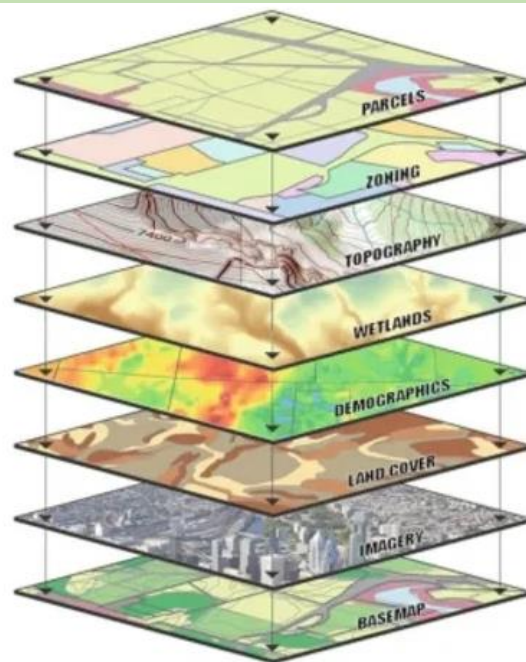
1. Installing & Overview of QGIS interface.

5. Joining excel data into attribute table.

• Advanced Spatial Analysis and Map Production

1. Extracting elevation data from DEM
2. Cartography and Map Layout
